But the deal did not close on or after Sept. 17, the scheduled date, according to a letter dated Wednesday from Alcatel-Lucent Corporate Counsel Lewis M. Lefkowitz, notifying township officials that the agreement had been "terminated."

Ward had no further comment.

D. Charles Houder, vice president of sales and acquisitions at Preferred Unlimited Inc., said the company and Alcatel-Lucent are in talks. "We are in confiden-

tial discussions with Lucent to see if we can get to a closing," Houder said, declining to comment further.

The sale is controversial.

Preferred Real Estate Investments had agreed to purchase the property and hoped to build 1.5 million square feet of commercial facilities. They also wanted a housing component —
